TWICE DAILY ROAD CLOSURE AT ALCONBURY SCHOOL FROM SEPTEMBER 2020

Alconbury School has been approved to be part of the Government School Streets project commencing 1st September 2020. This means that there will be a safe zone with volunteer operated barriers either side of the school and access to Alconbury Surgery car-park via Manor Lane only.

Morning from 8:30 am to 9:20 am

Afternoon from 2:45 pm to 3:25 pm

The temporary closure of the road during these times is intended to help implement social distancing (giving families space outside school to wait safely at a social distance from other families) and encourage active travel, with the added benefit of reducing congestion and pollution at our school gates and most importantly improving safety for our children and families on their way to and from school.

This is being arranged by Cambridgeshire County Council using a **Temporary Traffic Regulation Order** which will run from the start of term in September 2020 until the end of summer term in July 2021.
